Rafaela Rosário is an assistant professor at the University of Minho and the Research Centre in Nursing director. She is also a researcher at the Health Sciences Research Unit: Nursing (UICISA: E). Rafaela Rosário has significant experience running and leading community intervention and observational studies. Currently, she leads a cluster-randomized trial in schools, co-developing an intervention program with children and stakeholders to prevent obesity and non-communicable diseases among schools from vulnerable conditions. Rafaela Rosário has (co)-authored over 70 journal papers, book chapters, and conference and workshop papers. With a vast research network, including Schools for Health in Europe, the European Public Health Association and the COVID-HL network, she has a track record of collaboration at national and international levels.

Outi Savolainen, Ph.D., is a post-doctoral researcher who works as a University Lecturer at the University of Eastern Finland, Department of Nursing Science. Her research focuses on the mental health promotion of children. She has worked in EU-funded research and development projects dedicated to children's health promotion. Outi Savolainen is a member of Schools for Health in Europe (SHE) research group.
